Course Overview

This course presents the fundamental concepts, perspectives, and methods of sociology. Course topics include culture and society, socialization and the life cycle, social interaction and everyday life, social power and inequality, work and economic life, marriage and the family, gender and social change and social movements. *In many ways this course is about every life and social interaction so it is important to get and stay involved in class.*
